Universal level – the level of provision the school offers to all pupils including those who may have special educational needs, funded via the age weighted pupil unit (AWPU)

SEN Support - a more personalised provision offered to pupils who have SEN, funded via the school's SEN Notional Budget

EHC Plan Support – a highly personalised provision to support the needs of pupils with EHC Plans, funded via top up funding from the high needs block
