Dear Parent/Carer,

Since our return to school on 8<sup>th</sup> March 2021, it has become noticeable that some girls are wearing stretchy skirts that are quite short. This type of skirt does not conform to the school uniform policy and the material they are made from makes the skirts move up girls' legs and become even shorter.

I would like to bring to your attention to the fact that section 7.2 of the school uniform policy clearly states:

- Plain black knee-length school skirt. Skirts containing Lycra are not permitted.
