COVID vaccinations will be available for pupils in school on the 25th and 26th January. The vaccines are available to all pupils aged 12 or over. The main purpose of the COVID-19 school age vaccination programme is to provide protection those who receive the vaccine, to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in the wider population and protecting some of our most vulnerable people. Transmission rates within this age group are particularly high, leading to significant disruption and a high level of absences. During the vaccination delivery, we will maintain the range of measures we have in place to keep you safe from COVID-19.
