

All students should wear a navy blue blazer with the school logo



- Optional choice to wear a plain navyblue V-neck pullover (boys or girls)
- No motifs or fashion items



All students should wear a white shirt



 Your shirt must be tucked into your trousers/skirt at all times



We expect everyone to wear the correct school tie



- If you come to school without a tie, you have to sign out a tie to borrow for the day.
- If you lose or damage the tie, you will be charged the cost to replace it.



We expect all students to wear suitable trousers:



The trousers sold by our uniform suppliers are of a width and fabric that conform to our uniform code. Parents are free to purchase black trousers from supermarkets or other suppliers, provided they follow the uniform code.

- trousers containing denim or Lycra
- Boot cut, drainpipe, tight, tapered, or turn up style trousers

We expect everyone to wear black school shoes





The uniform policy states:

"Open-toed, backless shoes, trainers, or pumps are not permitted" and "Boots are not permitted"



Wear trainers, pumps or boots







Wear footwear with any logo, adornment or motif











Wear footwear with coloured stitching or laces







Wear footwear with colour on any part of the shoe







We expect everyone to wear a navy blue, black or grey coat to school









Hairstyles...

- Hairstyles should be neat and smart
- Hair should be a single, natural colour, no shorter than a grade 2
- No extreme styles, including 'tramlines', sculpting, shaving, patterns, or undercuts.
- Hair adornments are not permitted
- Use of gels or styling products should be minimal
- No bandanas, durags, or baseball caps
- Hairbands, scrunchies, and toggles (girls) must be plain: navy blue or black only
- Headscarves should be navy blue or black
- Turbans must be plain black or navy blue and unadorned





Jewellery...

- Only a pair of stud
 earrings, a single plain
 ring, a single plain
 necklace, and a watch may
 be worn. Smartwatches
 are not permitted.
- No other body piercing is permitted
- No zips, chains, wide belts, bars, or ear stretchers



Make-up, Nails and Fake Tan

Make-up: is not permitted. False eyelashes are not permitted.

Nails: false nails and nail extensions are not

permitted. Nail varnish is not permitted.


Fake tan: is not permitted
