On Thursday 2nd March it is World Book Day (WBD). This year, we will be collaborating with the English department and hosting 'World Book Week', where your child can get involved in activities, competitions, author talks and much more, with plenty of prizes up for grabs.

Scan the code with your mobile phone; this will take you to your online voucher to use in any participating bookshop or supermarket to purchase the WBD £1 book or £1 off the cost of another book in-store.
