Each morning, breakfast will be available for students to come and prepare for the day ahead.

We also have a quiet space at lunchtime in case any student wants to have some quiet time before their afternoon exam. After school, we have prioritised study support for whatever subjects have exams the following day. On two occasions, Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> February, students have a long English exam in the afternoon. Therefore, students will be told that the study support subjects for that day will be available for them to ask any last-minute questions or pick up any resources they may wish to work on at home. Where students have an option of subjects to go to on an evening, Mr Dix will be getting individual students to choose in advance so we know where each student is expected to go.



It is important all students know where and when to be for their exams to reduce stress levels. Morning exams will start at 9:00 am and, therefore, the following needs to take place:
