## Re: Admissions Policy Consultation 2026/2027

In accordance with the School Admissions Code, 2021, St Michael's Church of England High School is required to consult on its admission arrangements at least every seven years or when changes to the arrangements are proposed.

Our proposed Admissions Arrangements and Oversubscription Criteria for the academic year 2026-2027 is available to view on our website at <a href="https://st-michaels.sandwell.sch.uk/admissions/">https://st-michaels.sandwell.sch.uk/admissions/</a>. Please note that a proposed major change to the Admissions Criteria is the removal of attendance at a place of worship as an admission criterion.

The consultation is commencing on 11<sup>th</sup> November 2024 and will conclude at 12 noon on the 23<sup>rd</sup> of December 2024.

These arrangements are for students who will be starting secondary school in September 2026 or requesting admission to the school between September 2026 and July 2027. The Governing Board of St Michael's Church of England High School is responsible for offering or refusing places at the school. We would welcome your views on the proposed arrangements.

The admission arrangements policy has been reviewed and updated. The consultation document is enclosed.
